

Safety Net Grant FAQ's - 2020-2021

Who can apply?

See eligibility requirements

When are the final applications due?

Applications and all requested supporting documentation must be uploaded by 1/24/20 by midnight

When and how will funding decisions be shared?

Each applicant will receive a funding decision letter by 3/31/20

What is the maximum funding amount per award granted?

Max funding amount is \$20,000 per award

What is the term of funding?

These are one-year grants that will be disbursed 1/12 each month starting July 2020-June2021

Can individual organizations apply or do organizations need to apply collaboratively?

Individual organizations can apply for this round of safety net grants; however this will be the last year for individual program requests. All future requests will need to be part of a collaborative project aligned with one or more of United Way's Community Goals.

What are the requirements of organizations who received a safety-net grant?

If our organization receives United Way funding through a collective impact grant, can I apply for safety net funding?

Yes, eligible organizations can apply for funding through various grant opportunities from United Way

Reporting out requirements

See sample MOU – funded partners will be required to complete a 6 month and 12 month review that will include reporting out on outputs and outcomes identified in logic model, narrative questions, and the request for an impact story.
